- What is balance Balance is how the elements of art are arranged in an artwork to make the artwork look even or uneven.

You were then practicing your designs for your final leluja designs.
You will be finishing your design today and then you will choose your final paper.
Before we choose any paper we want to choose carefully to give our artwork more personal meaning.

Our big idea for our class is Art Expresses how we feel. A big idea is like a topic that we will look at and experiment with the entire time we are in art class.

Color can help us express how we feel because certain colors have certain feelings assigned to them. This is because when we look at certain colors colors they can give us certain feelings and the colors you choose can change the feeling or your artwork.

So now I am going to quickly show you how to draw your design on your final paper for your leluja cutout

1-fold

2-find the crease

3- draw the contour line of your tree and your ground

4- check to make sure its on the crease

4-add and take away elements to your tree, making sure whatever you draw is connected to your tree and is on the outside contour, the crease, or the bottom.

5- Make sure if you want a line, you draw two and leave some space so when you cut it out, it's a line. For instance the stem of a flower.

Use your pencil lightly because it is hard to erase. Remember all your pencil will be on the back of your leluja and you wont be able to see it, so don't worry if you do have erasure marks.

We will not be cutting today, if you get it drawn onto you paper, I need to check it first to make sure it will work.

Make sure your choose a final design from your sheet, if you are not happy with your design you may try another one on the back
